FAMPO RESOLUTION 08-46

A RESOLUTION DIRECTING FAMPO/GWRC STAFF TO UTILIZE VANASSE HANGEN BRUSTLIN, INC. (VHB), AS ON-CALL CONSULTANTS, TO WORK WITH THE FAMPO TECHNICAL COMMITTEE, VDOT AND FLUOR/TRANSURBAN TO SITE NEW COMMUTER PARKING LOTS IN THE GEORGE WASHINGTON REGION FOR THE I-95 HOT LANES.

WHEREAS, the I-95/I-395 HOT Lanes Transit/TDM Study conducted by the Department of Rail and Public Transportation (DRPT) has recommended that \$100,000,000 be used in the FAMPO Region for increased Transit/TDM Services in the Region, and

WHEREAS, a portion of this money will be used to construct new transit centers and commuter parking facilities around the I-95/U.S. Route 1 Corridors, and

WHEREAS, the Fredericksburg Area Metropolitan Planning Organization has funds identified in the FY09-12 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to perform a study to site these commuter parking facilities, and

WHEREAS, FAMPO staff recommends that Vanasse Hangen Brustlin, Inc. (VHB), one of FAMPO's on-call consultants be selected to perform the study, and

WHEREAS, VHB has already begun this process in North Stafford County as a part of the recently completed U.S. Route 1 Multimodal Corridor Study

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FREDERICKSBURG AREA
METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION, THAT FAMPO/GWRC STAFF IS
AUTHORIZED TO EXPEND UP TO \$100,000 TO PERFORM THIS STUDY, SITING
COMMUTER PARKING LOTS ALONG THE I-95/U.S. ROUTE 1 CORRIDORS AND
VANASSE HANGEN BRUSTLIN, INC (VHB) WILL BE THE CONSULTANT
CONDUCTING THE STUDY**
