

The Fredericksburg Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (FAMPO) has announced a public comment period for the Draft Public Participation Plan (PPP) as required by the United States Department of Transportation's metropolitan planning regulations 23 Code of Federal Regulations Part 450. The public comment will begin on Monday, September 24, 2012 and will end on Monday, November 19, 2012. Written comments will be accepted until 2:00 p.m. on November 19, 2012. Spoken comments will be accepted during a public hearing scheduled to begin no earlier than 7:10 p.m. during the Policy Committee meeting on November 19, 2012. The public hearing will be held at the GWRC/FAMPO office located on 406 Princess Anne Street in Fredericksburg, Virginia.

The purpose of the Public Participation Plan (PPP) is to serve as a guide in the development of public outreach strategies that encourage the citizen's involvement in the regional transportation planning process.
