A Toll Road For Fredericksburg

The Fredericksburg City Council has voted Tuesday in favor of creating the George Washington Toll Road Authority. The council approves electing three council members to help in developing a toll road that would run from I-95 to Route 3 through Celebrate Virginia. While council member Kerry Devine had some concerns in adding another committee for council members, Councilman Matthew Kelly believes it is necessary.

"The new toll road authority's gonna have to make a decision on how high the tolls are going to be, where the tolls are going to be set to fund the project, or look at possibilities of making additional funding to fund other projects," Kelly said.

Fredericksburg council members would join those from Spotsylvania County and VDOT in the authority.
