

# Express lanes to impact 95; Harrison Road work planned

As is to be expected until the Interstate 95 express lanes project is completed, there will be delays throughout that zone this week. Among the numerous impacts, expect nighttime southbound lane closures on the primary lanes in the Quantico area this week.

Elsewhere, traffic will be cut back to one lane for work on Harrison Road in Spotsylvania on Tuesday night and during the day Wednesday.

Paving work will lead to lane closures this week on U.S. 1 in Stafford and Spotsylvania.

## VDOT Hot Spots

### Interstate 95 Southbound

(New) Sunday-Monday, 10:30 p.m. – 5 a.m.; multiple southbound lane closures and detour near Exit 148 (Quantico Marine Corps Base).

The hours of operation and lane closures will be:

Sunday-Monday: One lane closed 10:30 p.m.

Sunday-Monday: Two lanes closed 11:30 p.m. – 5 a.m.

Sunday-Monday: Full closure of all I-95 southbound lanes, detour in effect, between 1 a.m. – 3 a.m.

Detour: I-95 southbound traffic will be detoured to Exit 148, Quantico Marine Corps Base (Russell Road) east to Route 1 south to Garrisonville Road (Route 610) and back to I-95.

### Interstate 95

(Update) Monday-Friday, 9 a.m. – 2:30 p.m.; crews will be repairing guardrail as needed at various locations on I-95 northbound and southbound between mile marker 101 in Caroline County and mile marker 170 in Prince William County. Motorists should expect lane closures in this mobile work zone.

### Spotsylvania County

#### Harrison Road

(New) Tuesday, 9:30 p.m. – 4:30 a.m. and Wednesday, 9 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.; Single lane closure on Harrison Road in Spotsylvania County between Salem Church Road/Leavells Road intersection and the

I-95 overpass. Motorists will be restricted to one lane in the work zone, and can expect minor travel delays. Contractors will be repairing damaged roadway surface.

### **Route 1**

(New) Sunday-Friday, 8 p.m. – 5 a.m.; crews will be milling on northbound Route 1 (Jefferson Davis Highway) between just south of Route 711 (Southpoint Parkway) to south of Route 1489 (Market Street). Motorists should expect alternating lane closures in this mobile work zone.

### **Stafford County**

#### **Route 1**

(New) Sunday-Thursday, 7 p.m. – 4 a.m.; crews will be milling and paving on northbound and southbound Route 1 (Jefferson Davis Highway) just south of Austin Park Drive to just south of Austin Run Boulevard in Stafford County. Motorists should expect alternating lane closures in this mobile work zone.

### **Caroline County**

#### **Interstate 95 Northbound**

(Update) Sunday–Thursday, 9:00 p.m. – 5:00 a.m.; crews will be paving I-95 northbound from mile marker 108 at the Ladysmith Safety Rest Area to mile marker 115.

Sunday: Two lanes closed 10 p.m. – 5 a.m.

Monday – Thursday: One lane closed at 9 p.m. Two lanes closed between 10 p.m. – 5 a.m.

### **I-95 Express Lanes Project**

FULL CLOSURE OF I-95 SOUTH at Exit 148, Russell Road near Quantico Sunday and Monday nights, July 28 and 29, for steel beam installation. There will also be extended nighttime HOV closures this weekend.

*Nighttime work – Closures occur between 9 p.m. and 4:30 a.m. Monday – Thursday unless otherwise noted. Closures occur between 11 p.m. and 9:30 a.m. Friday and Saturday nights.*

I-395/95 reversible HOV lanes from Dumfries Rd. (Route 234) to Duke St. (Route 236) – Road closed Monday – Thursday nights from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. for excavation, backfill, barrier demolition and conduit installation. Traffic will be directed to use the general purpose lanes.

I-395/95 reversible HOV lanes from Just north of Edsall Rd. to Franconia-Springfield Pkwy. (Route 289) – Road closed Friday and Saturday nights from 11 p.m. to 10 a.m. Traffic will be directed to use the general purpose lanes.

I-95 south from Exit 152, Dumfries Rd. (Route 234) to Telegraph Road overpass – Two lanes closed Monday – Friday nights for bridge work and pavement markings. Expect intermittent full road closures

of up to 30 minutes after midnight.

I-95 south ramp to Exit 161, Route 1 – Ramp closed Monday – Friday nights for steel beam work. Traffic will be directed to continue south and take Exit 158, Prince William Pkwy (Route 249) east and follow signs to Route 1.

I-95 south from Exit 148, Russell Rd. (Quantico), to Exit 143, Garrisonville Rd. (Route 610) – Road closed Sunday – Wednesday nights from 1 p.m. to 3 p.m. for steel beam installation. Traffic will be directed to take Exit 148 east, to Route 1 south, to Garrisonville Rd. west and follow signs back onto I-95 south.

I-95 north from Pohick Rd. overpass to I-495 – Three lanes closed Monday – Saturday nights for ground work.

I-95 north and south between I-495 and Exit 158, Prince William Pkwy. (Route 294) – Single lane closed Monday – Saturday nights for survey, ground work, barrier movement, and excavation. Closure will not be more than two miles.

I-95 north and south from Exit 158, Prince William Pkwy. (Route 294) to Cardinal Dr. overpass- Single lane closed Monday – Friday nights for ground work.

I-95 north and south between Cardinal Dr. overpass to Exit 143, Garrisonville Rd. (Route 610) – Single lane closed Monday – Saturday nights for ground work.

I-95 north at Telegraph Rd. overpass – Two lanes closed Sunday – Wednesday nights for steel beam installation. Expect intermittent full road closures of up to 30 minutes after midnight.

I-395 north and south between I-495 and Exit 4, Seminary Rd. (Route 420) – Single lane closed Monday – Saturday nights for barrier, foundation, ground and drainage work.

I-395 south from Exit 4, Seminary Rd. (Route 420) to Exit 2, Edsall Rd. (Route 648) – Two right lanes closed Monday – Saturday nights for barrier work.

I-395 north from I-495 to Exit 4, Seminary Rd. (Route 420) – Two lanes closed Monday – Saturday nights for ground work.

Franconia-Springfield Pkwy. (Route 289) east and west at I-95 – Single lane closed Monday – Friday nights for survey and demolition work.

Loisdale Rd. north and south at the Fairfax County Pkwy. (Route 286) – Single lane closed Monday – Saturday nights for ground work.

Furnace Rd. at I-95 – Two lanes closed Monday – Friday nights night for steel beam installation. Expect intermittent full road closures for up to 30 minutes after midnight.

Gordon Blvd. (Route 123) east and west at I-95 – Single lane closes Monday – Saturday nights for ground work.

Route 1 south at Russell Rd. – Right lane closed Sunday – Wednesday nights for steel beam installation.

Joplin Rd. (Route 619) east or west at I-95 – Road closed Monday – Friday nights for ground work. Two-way traffic will be directed by flagger.

***Daytime work – Closures occur Monday – Thursday between 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and Friday from 9:30***

***a.m. to noon unless otherwise noted.***

I-95/I-95/395 reversible HOV lanes between I-495 and Dumfries Rd. (Route 234) – Single lane closed Monday – Friday for excavation, ground and survey work, material delivery.

I-95/395 reversible HOV lanes between Dale Blvd. and Opitz Blvd. overpasses – Single lane closed Saturday from 6 a.m. to 2 p.m. for ground work.

I-95/395 reversible HOV lanes from just north of Edsall Rd. to Franconia-Springfield Pkwy. (Route 289) – Road closed from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. Saturday for ground work. Traffic will be directed to use the general purpose lanes.

I-95 north and south between I-495 and Exit 143, Garrisonville Rd. (Route 610) – Single lane closed Monday – Friday for survey, girder installation barrier placement and equipment movement. Closure will not be more than two miles.

I-95 south to Exit 169, Franconia-Springfield (Route 644) – Single lane of ramp closed Monday – Friday for ground work.

I-95 south to Exit 161, Route 1 south – Single lane of ramp closed Monday – Friday for bridge work.

I-395 north and south between Exit 4, Seminary Rd. (Route 420) and I-495 – Single lane closed Monday – Friday for drainage, survey and ground work.

Cherokee Ave. north from Edsall Rd. to Duke St. (Route 236) – Single lane closed Monday – Friday for utility work. Two-way traffic will be directed by a flagger.

Franconia-Springfield Pkwy. (Route 289) west to I-395 north – Single lane of ramp closed Monday – Friday for ground work.

Alban Rd. north and south from Boudinot Rd. to Fullerton Rd. – Single lane closed Monday – Friday for ground work.

Route 1 north to I-95 north/HOV – Single lane of ramp closed Monday – Friday for ground work, clearing and erosion control work.

Furnace Rd. east and west at I-95 – Single lane closed Monday – Friday for bridge work.

Occoquan Rd. east and west at I-95 – Single lane closed Monday – Friday for bridge work.

Gordon Blvd. east and west at I-95 – Single lane closed Monday – Friday for ground work.

Prince William Pkwy. (Route 294) from Telegraph Rd. to commuter lot entrance – Single lane closed Monday – Friday for ground work.

Opitz Blvd. west to I-95 north – Single lane of ramp closed Monday – Friday for ground work.

Russell Rd. east and west at I-95 – Single lane closed Monday – Friday for overhang work.

Joplin Rd. (Route 619) east and west at I-95 – Single lane closed Monday – Friday for ground work.

I-95 north and south from Exit 158, Prince William Pkwy. (Route 294) to Exit 152, Dumfries Rd. (Route 234) – Two lanes closed Monday – Friday nights for striping.

***Daytime work – Closures occur Monday – Thursday between 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and Friday from 9:30 a.m. to noon unless otherwise noted.***

I-95 north and south between Prince William Pkwy. (Route 294) to Exit 152, Dumfries Rd. (Route 234) – Single lane closed Monday – Friday for light pole installation.

I-95 south collector distributor road at Exit 156, Dale Blvd. – Right lane closed Monday – Friday for light pole installation.
