FAMPO RESOLUTION FY 07-39

A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THAT THE GEORGE WASHINGTON REGIONAL COMMISSION APPROVE THE SELECTION OF VANASSE HANGEN BRUSTLIN, INC. (VHB) AND KIMLEY-HORN AND ASSOCIATES, INC. AS ON-CALL CONSULTANTS TO PERFORM TRANSPORTATION PLANNING WORK AND RECOMMENDING THAT VHB BE AUTHORIZED TO CONDUCT THE WORK FOR THE MULTI-MODAL CORRIDOR STUDY ON U.S. 1 IN NORTH STAFFORD COUNTY AND THE FIRST TASK ORDER UNDER THESE CONTRACTS

WHEREAS, the FAMPO Board authorized staff to solicit proposals for on-call transportation planning services,

WHEREAS, a request for proposals was issued and nine proposals were submitted, and

WHEREAS, a Selection Committee comprised of staff from FAMPO, Stafford County, Spotsylvania County, the City of Fredericksburg and PRTC reviewed and rated the proposals and conducted interviews with a short list of five firms, and

WHEREAS, the Selection Committee recommended that VHB and Kimley-Horn each be awarded a contract for these services that will last 3 years with 2) 1 year extensions. The amount of the contracts being issued shall not exceed \$2,000,000 each. These guidelines are governed by the George Washington Regional Commission's Procurement Policy; adopted on April 16, 2007, and

WHEREAS, the FAMPO Board finds that utilizing a low bid method for selection of transportation planning consultants is not in the economic best interests of the Region, as the quality and experience of consulting firms is critical to success;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FREDERICKSBURG AREA METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION THAT IT RECOMMENDS EXECUTING CONTRACTS FOR ON-CALL TRANSPORTATION PLANNING SERVICES WITH VANASSE HANGEN BRUSTLIN, INC. (VHB) AND KIMLEY-HORN AND ASSOCIATES, INC., AND

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE FREDERICKSBURG METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION RECOMMENDS THAT VHB BE AUTHORIZED TO CONDUCT THE WORK REQUIRED FOR THE MULTI-MODAL CORRIDOR STUDY ON U.S. 1 IN NORTH STAFFORD COUNTY AS ITS FIRST TASK ORDER IN ITS CONTRACT, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$200,000, AND

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE FREDERICKSBURG METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION RECOMMENDS THAT KIMLEY-HORN BE AUTHORIZED TO CONDUCT THE WORK REQUIRED FOR THE MULTI-MODAL CORRIDOR STUDY ON LAFAYETTE BOULEVARD AS ITS FIRST TASK ORDER IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$300,000, AND

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE FREDERICKSBURG METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION RECOMMENDS THAT KIMLEY-HORN BE AUTHORIZED TO UTILIZE CORDELL AND CRUMLEY, A SUBCONTRACTOR, TO ASSIST WITH PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT ASSOCIATED WITH THE REGIONAL TRANSIT POLICY PLAN AND THE 2035 CONTSTRAINED LONG RANGE PLAN AS ITS SECOND TASK ORDER, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$60,000.
