The Fredericksburg Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (FAMPO) would like to formally thank the Virginia National Defense Industrial Authority (VNDIA) for the opportunity to receive funding to aid in the preparation of the *U.S. Route 1 Multimodal Corridor Study*, which recommends a series of short, mid-term and long-term multimodal transportation improvements for the U.S. Route 1 Corridor in north Stafford and southern Prince William Counties. These improvements include the area around both entrances to the eastern portion of MCB Quantico (Russell and Joplin/ Fuller Roads) in preparation for MCB Quantico's anticipated Base Relocation and Closure (BRAC) Actions.

This study describes the existing conditions of the corridor, which were then used to develop and examine a wide range of multimodal (roadway, transit and bicycle and pedestrian) concepts to improve mobility, safety and accessibility for all modes of transportation within the study area. This study takes into account the projected increases in traffic that will be created by MCB Quantico's BRAC Actions. The United States Marine Corps have been involved in the preparation of this study and its recommendations, as they will play an instrumental role in the implementation of the recommended actions around MCB Quantico and its entrances.
