

Hearing set for Route 3 study

PUBLIC CAN COMMENT ON Route 3 PLANS

A hearing focused on a study looking at ways to prepare for potential future traffic increases on the western area of State Route 3 in Spotsylvania County will be held on Wednesday.

The hearing will allow the public to comment on recommendations by the Virginia Department of Transportation and Spotsylvania.

The meeting starts at 7 p.m., and will be held at the Chancellor Ruritan Club at 5994 Plank Road.

The study area covers a nine-mile section of Route 3 between Gordon Road and the Orange County line.

During an earlier hearing on the study, officials said growth in that area could add some 60,000 vehicle trips per day.
