# Upcoming FAMPO Major Required Work Activities for 2020

  - TIP Amendments (Ongoing to April)
3. FY 21-24 TIP and 2045 LRTP Amendment:
  - Air Quality Conformity (January to April, 2020)
  - Draft Documents for Public Involvement (February 27<sup>th</sup>)
  - Approval (April 20<sup>th</sup>)
  - TIP Amendments (Ongoing starting in May)
4. Follow up on 2019 Certification Review
  - UPWP Quarterly Reports (Every 3 months: January, April, July, October, etc.)
  - New TPB/FAMPO MOU (Ongoing to June)
  - Performance Based Planning and Programming (PBPP) LOA (Ongoing to June)
5. Completion of Lafayette Blvd Transit Study (March)
