**Subject:** FAMPO CLRP Amendment - Proposed Schedule

Hi Jim and Dan,

Please find below a proposed schedule and a couple questions for the FAMPO CLRP amendment. This proposed schedule is independent of the current schedule for the TIP. I would like to get your take to see if this is feasible as far as you guys are concerned with the air quality conformity process on the CLRP:

1. 3/2/2020 – TAC take action to recommend amended CLRP project list
  - a. There are some questions that I am asking the VDOT district today at 12:30 that may affect the dollar amount FAMPO needs to remove from the list in order to fit constraint. Regardless of those answers and the dollar amount, TAC will recommend a fiscally constrained list on 3/2.
2. 3/16/2020 – Policy Committee votes to approve amended CLRP project list
  - a. Policy Committee ~~directs TAC to hold special meeting on 3/19 and~~ authorizes TAC to approve draft air quality conformity analysis *for public review* (specific to the CLRP)
  - b. Policy Committee directs FAMPO staff to hold public comment on the draft CLRP amendment and draft ACQA report from ~~3/20/2020 to 4/19/2020~~ *4/8/20 to 5/8/20*
1. ~~3/17/2020 – 3/18/2020 – VDOT Environmental Division runs air quality conformity on the approved amended 2045 CLRP project list~~
3. ~~3/19~~*4/6/2020* – *ICG Meeting to kick-off amended CLRP conformity analysis.* TAC ~~(and possibly ICG) holds special meeting to~~ *subsequently* approves draft air quality conformity analysis *for public review* (specific to the CLRP)
4. ~~3/20~~*4/8/2020* – FAMPO staff initiates a 30-day public comment period on draft CLRP amendment and draft ACQA report
5. ~~4/19~~*5/8/2020* – 30-day public comment period ends, *VDOT and FAMPO staff address adverse comments as needed*

6. ~~4/20~~5/18/2020 – Policy Committee approves the FY21-24 TIP, 2045 CLRP amendment, and AQCA report *for submittal to FHWA for approval.*

This proposed schedule pushes back the CLRP amendment timeline just a little bit and allows for its approval at the FAMPO Policy Committee meeting on 4/20 as originally scheduled.

A few questions:

1. Is this schedule feasible for you guys and does it include all of the necessary steps?
2. Would the ICG need to meet at the conclusion of the FAMPO Policy Committee meeting on 3/16 once the list is approved, or is an ICG meeting before the special TAC meeting on 3/19 sufficient?
3. Even if feasible on your end, are there any glaring issues you see with this proposed schedule before we run it by our Policy Committee to get a green light to move forward?
