Garrisonville Road Widening

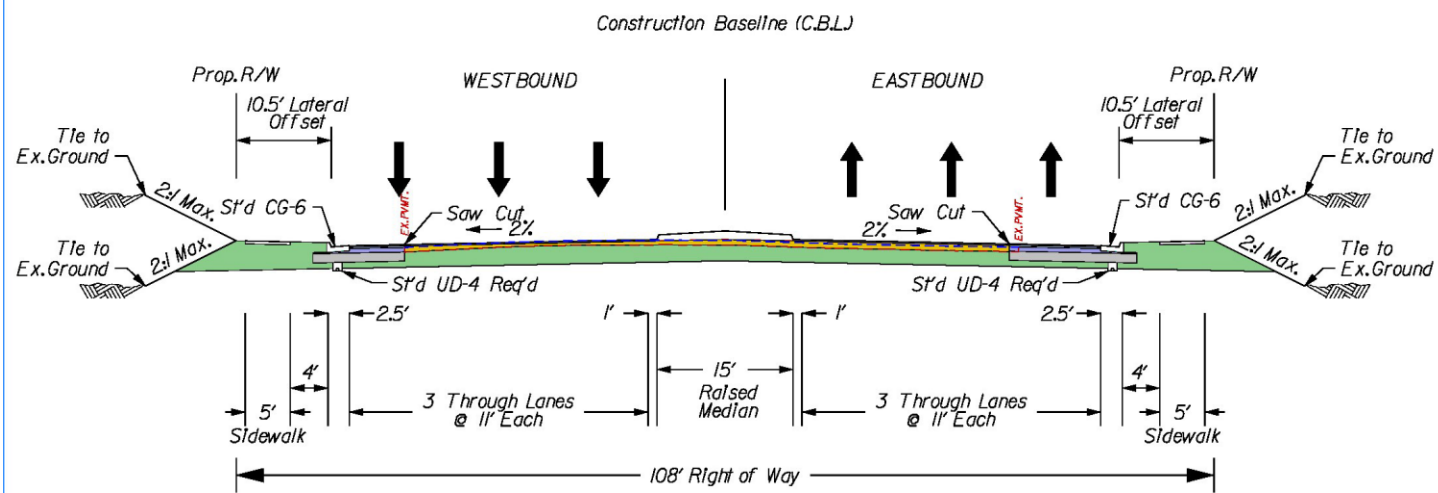


Scope: Widen approximately 1.4 miles of Garrisonville Road (SR-610), between Eustace Road (SR-751) and Shelton Shop Road (SR-648), to a six-lane divided roadway with median, curb & gutter, 5-foot sidewalks and crosswalks for pedestrians, and new FRED bus shelters at the Medical Center of Stafford and DMV

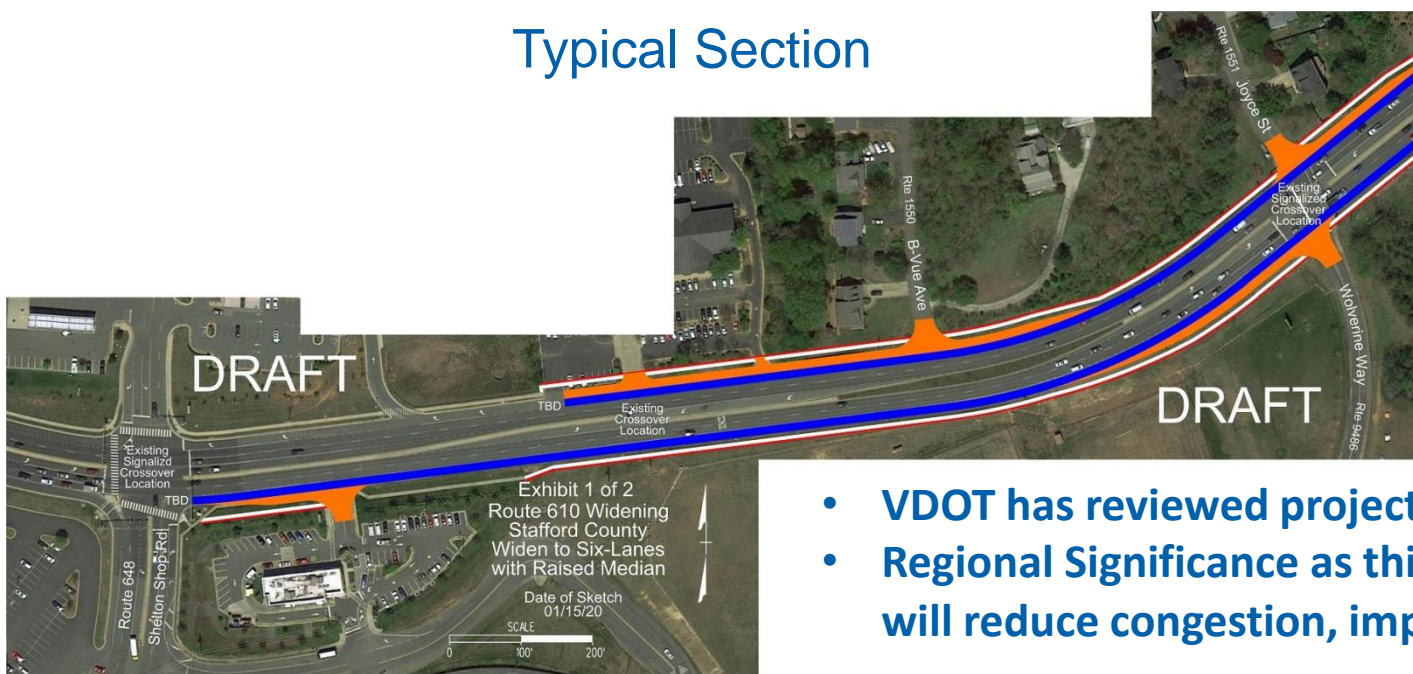
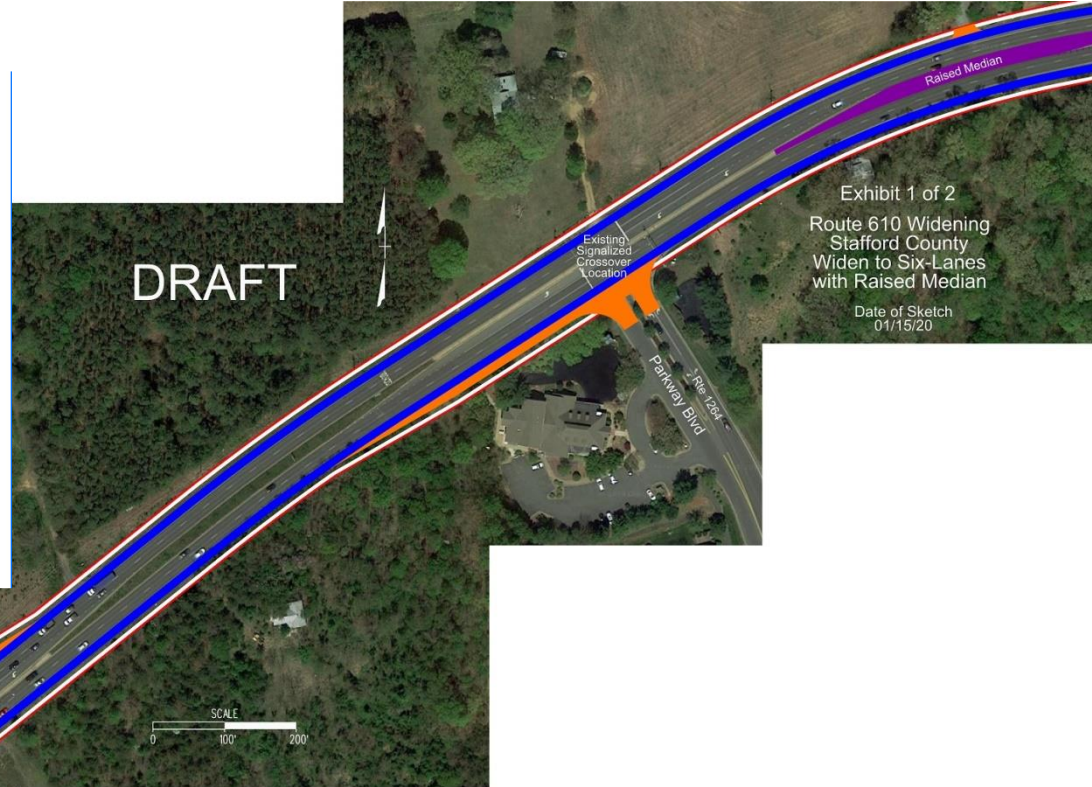
Estimated Cost: \$29.5 Million

- **Local Funding: \$9.3 Million**
 - **Anticipated Other State/Federal Funds: \$8.7 Million**
 - **Anticipated SMART Scale Ask: \$11.5 Million**
- ❖ **Anticipated to score well across the Category B SMART Scale Criteria by increasing accessibility to jobs and multimodal choices (25%), increasing safety by reducing crashes (20%), fostering economic development and intermodal access (20%), reducing congestion (15%) and improving air quality (10%)**

Typical Section



- Meets VTRANS Need for intersection safety improvements at Shenandoah Lane, improving access to transit, and for pedestrian safety improvements along the roadway.

- VDOT has reviewed project and determined it meets pre-screening criteria
- Regional Significance as this project is included in FAMPO's 2045 LRTP; project will reduce congestion, improve air quality and improve multimodal access
