

RESOLUTION NO. 21-01

**APPROVING THE GEORGE WASHINGTON REGIONAL COMMISSION ROUND 4
SMART SCALE PROJECT APPLICATIONS**

WHEREAS, the George Washington Regional Commission (“the Commission”) serves as the Planning District Commission for PD 16; and

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth of Virginia is accepting Smart Scale project applications from June 9, 2020 through August 3, 2020 for the Fiscal Year 2022-2027 Six-Year Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, the Commission is eligible to submit up to four project applications for Smart Scale; and

WHEREAS, the Commission’s member-jurisdiction staff have met with GWRC/FAMPO staff several times from January to July, 2020 to develop regional Smart Scale priority projects, and have identified eight potential regional projects with four scheduled to be submitted by GWRC and four by FAMPO;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the George Washington Regional Commission that it hereby authorizes staff to submit the following projects for Smart Scale funding consideration in the Fiscal Year 2022-2027 Six-Year Improvement Program:

1. [US-17 Business STARS Study Improvements]
2. [US-1 and Layhill Rd Intersection Improvements]
3. [US-1 Turn Lane Extension & Shared Use Path (STARS)]
4. [Onville Road Widening]
5. [US 301/Rte 207 Study Crossover Improvements in King George]
