Re: Draft Project List for the *2050 Long Range Transportation Plan*

Dear FAMPO Policy Committee Members,

After hearing public comment on the draft project list for the *2050 Long Range Transportation Plan*, the Citizens Transportation Advisory Committee (CTAC) discussed residents' concerns that the draft project list did not contain a project or study that would add a third river crossing across the Rappahannock River.

Recognizing its advisory role to the Policy Committee, at its September committee meeting, CTAC voted 7 to 4 to formally convey the following concern:

A majority of CTAC members are concerned that the draft project list for the *2050 Long Range Transportation Plan* does not include a study that would examine building a third roadway crossing over the Rappahannock River. A majority of the committee believes such a project could alleviate congestion on Route 1 and I-95 and would give residents an option to avoid major travel corridors.

We respectfully request that the FAMPO Policy Committee contemplates CTAC's concern before Policy Committee members take action to approve the draft project list.
