

FAMPO RESOLUTION 22-12

**APPROVING THE 2050 LONG RANGE TRANSPORTATION PLAN (LRTP) AND FY21-24
TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP) AIR QUALITY CONFORMITY
REPORT**

WHEREAS, FAMPO is responsible for ensuring that the federally required metropolitan transportation planning process is carried out in the Fredericksburg region; and

WHEREAS, the FAMPO planning area is included in an air quality maintenance area; and

WHEREAS, federal regulations (Section 93.108 of the federal conformity rule and CFR part 450) require that fiscally constrained projects identified in the LRTP and TIP within a maintenance region demonstrate conformity to all applicable air quality regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) has performed the air quality conformity assessment, demonstrating compliance of the FAMPO 2050 LRTP and FY21-24 TIP; and


WHEREAS, during the public review process, staff was notified of the need to correct the terminus of the Dixon Street/Tidewater Trail Widening project in order to match the 2045 LRTP as planned and detailed in Attachment 1; and

WHEREAS, the public was given an opportunity to comment on the Air Quality Conformity Report from October 6, 2021 to November 5, 2021, with a public hearing on October 18, 2021, and no adverse comments were received;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Fredericksburg Area Metropolitan Planning Organization hereby endorses the Air Quality Conformity Report for the 2050 LRTP and FY 21-24 TIP and for submission to the Federal Highway Administration for approval.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Fredericksburg Area Metropolitan Planning Organization hereby approves modifying the eastern terminus of the Dixon Street/Tidewater Trail Widening project from the City Line to US-17/Mills Drive.
