## FAMPO RESOLUTION 16-16

### A RESOLUTION OF THE FREDERICKSBURG AREA METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION SETTING A PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD AND PUBLIC HEARING TO AMEND THE FY 2016 UNIFIED PLANNING WORK PROGRAM (UPWP)

**WHEREAS**, Federal guidelines require the development and adoption of a Unified Planning Work Program for the following federal fiscal year before June 30 of each year, and

**WHEREAS**, in light of new congestion problems on I-95 associated with the extension of the Express Lanes to Exit 143, the FAMPO Policy Committee desires to conduct a Phase I examination of I-95 to analyze new congestion problems on I-95 between mile point 149 and mile point 117 and their possible solutions in time for the next Round of HB2 project applications in the summer of 2016, and

**WHEREAS**, the FAMPO Policy Committee has directed staff to work with the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) to identify a scope, budget and funding sources for this analysis, and

**WHEREAS**, working with VDOT staff has completed this work to define a Phase 1 I-95 study at a cost of \$280,000, to be completed by June 2016 and to be funded by a combination of RSTP and State funds, and

**WHEREAS**, this work requires an amendment to the FY16 UPWP, as shown in the attachment to this Resolution.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FREDERICKSBURG AREA METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION THAT THE AMENDED FY 2016 UNIFIED PLANNING WORK PROGRAM BE ADVERTISED FOR A PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD COMMENCING ON NOVEMBER 18, 2015 AND LASTING UNTIL DECEMBER 17, 2015, AND A PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD DURING THE FAMPO POLICY COMMITTEE MEETING ON DECEMBER 14, 2015.
