## Update to Existing 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan

- Adopted 4/15/2013
- Target timeframe for completion: May, 2018

## Years: 2015 (Base) & 2045 (Horizon)

## FAMPO Area: Stafford, City, & Spotsylvania

- Fiscally constrained

## Rural Area in GWRC: Caroline & King George

- Not fiscally constrained

## Timeframe

- Fall, 2016 to Spring 2018
- Monthly FAMPO Updates: January, 2017 to Spring 2018

# Combining I-95 Phase 2 Effort with 2045 LRTP

## 1. Time savings

- One Advisory Committee for both

- Do both efforts concurrently

## 3. Increased coordination between I-95 Phase 2 study and LRTP

## 4. Consultant Work for I-95 Phase 2 Effort and 2045 LRTP:

- Draft Plan for FAMPO review – February 27<sup>th</sup> Policy and March 6<sup>th</sup> Technical Committee
- Final Plan for FAMPO action – March 20<sup>th</sup> Policy
