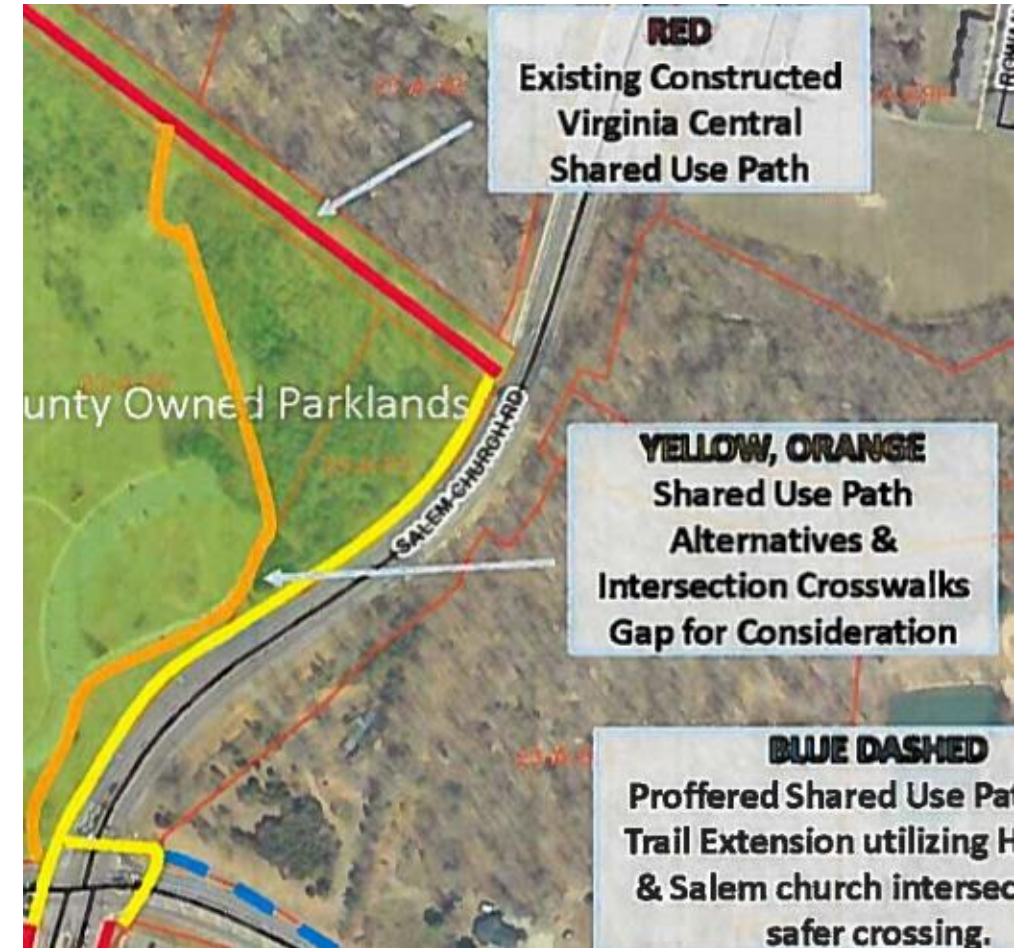

Fredericksburg TA Applications

- VCR Rails-to-Trails Project
 - provide finish grading, drainage repairs, and installation of dustless surface along the trail from Hazel Run to I-95 for 0.65 miles
- Kenmore Avenue Connector
 - design and construction to provide on-road bicycle facility on Kenmore Avenue, 0.92 miles, and for a short connecting trail from the northwest end of Kenmore Avenue to the Rappahannock Canal Trail.
- Mary Washington Hospital Connector
 - design and construction to establish an ADA ramp from the Normandy Village bridge to the Rappahannock Canal Trail (grade differential of 3.5 feet) and to construct a 240 foot long ramp from the Rappahannock Canal Trail to Mary Washington Boulevard (grade differential of 12 feet).

Spotsylvania TA Application

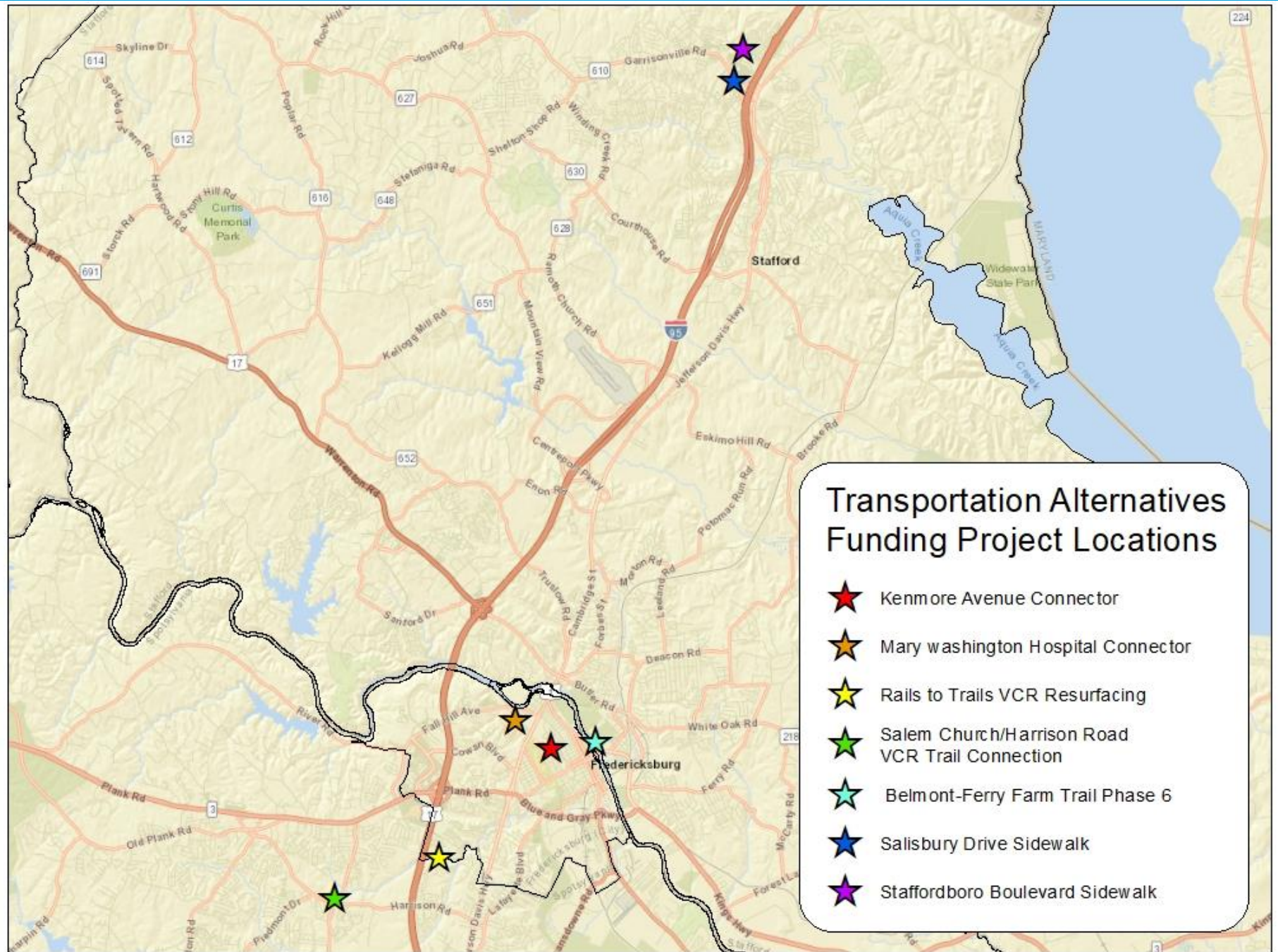
- Harrison Road/Salem Church Road Intersection to VCR Trail Connection Route
 - Design and construction of a shared-use path connecting the intersection of Harrison Road and Salem Church Road with the existing VCR Trail in Spotsylvania County.



Stafford TA Applications

- **Belmont-Ferry Farm Trail Phase 6**
 - Construction of approximately 4,700 feet of a multipurpose trail that will connect with existing pedestrian facilities near the intersection of Route 3 and River Road as well as the Chatham Bridge. This trail would also connect with a VDOT crossing improvement at Route 3 and Chatham Heights Road.
- **Salisbury Drive Sidewalk**
 - The Salisbury Drive Sidewalk project would construct approximately 900 feet of sidewalk between Garrisonville Road (SR-610) and the Mine Road Commuter Lot and include a pedestrian crossing signal at Greenspring Drive.
- **Staffordboro Sidewalk**
 - The Staffordboro Boulevard Sidewalk project would construct approximately 1,200 linear feet of 5'-wide concrete sidewalk between the VDOT Staffordboro Commuter Lot and Pike's Place, connecting the Sunningdale Meadows, Foxwood Village, and Woodstream residential neighborhoods.

Locations



- Transportation Alternatives Application Timeline
 - » July 1- Pre-Applications due through Smart Portal
 - » July 1 to August 1 - Validation period
 - » August 1 - Validation period ends, locality receives approval to go ahead with work on full application.
 - » **October 1**- Final TA Application Deadline
 - » **June 2020** – Final Selections approved by CTB Resolution
