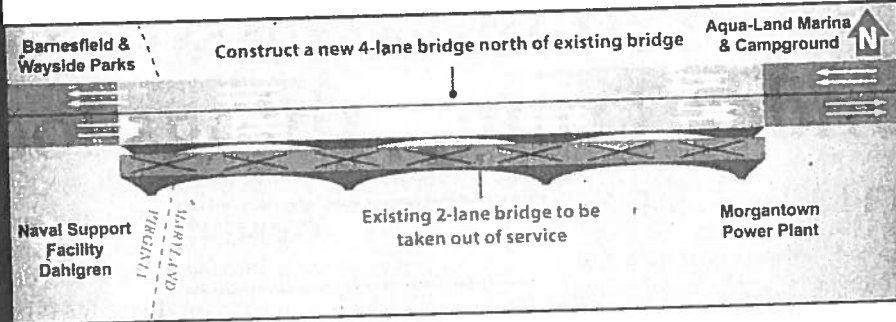

The new bridge will replace the current Harry W. Nice Memorial Bridge over US 301 between Charles County, MD and King George County, VA. Construction will begin in early 2020, and the new bridge will be open to traffic in 2023.

NEW POTOMAC RIVER CROSSING

CHARLES COUNTY, MD TO KING GEORGE COUNTY, VA

Standing at the base of the 75-year-old Governor Harry W. Nice Memorial Bridge, Governor Larry Hogan announced \$765 million in funding for construction of a new Potomac River crossing from Charles County, Maryland, to King George County, Virginia. This crossing is vital to the nation's security and to the quality of life of thousands of Marylanders who depend on this bridge daily for work, business, and recreation.



Existing Bridge:



With only one, narrow lane in each direction, the existing bridge causes near daily congestion and traffic issues. Routine maintenance and large-scale preservation efforts have significant traffic impacts.


